What you will need to bring:

One suitcase (or holdall or large rucksack) and one bedding pack. Plus one small handbag or rucksack on the minibus. All luggage will need to be dropped off at the **Church Centre** on **Thursday 18th July** any time between **3pm and 7:30pm**, so it can be loaded onto the lorry.

- Sleeping bag, air bed, pillow and blanket (in a named black bin-liner)
- Clothes for all weather conditions to last the week, and warm clothes to sleep in
- Wellies (named) and sturdy shoes
- Waterproof jacket
- Beachwear
- Sun cream, hayfever tablets, medication as required*
- Towels and wash kit/toiletries
- Bible, notebook and pen
- Spending money for tuck shop and trips out
- Plate, bowl, mug, water bottle and cutlery
- Phone charging USB cable (but not the plug)
- Musical instruments (if playing in band)

Please do not bring any other camping equipment – we provide all tents, chairs etc.

*Where parents instruct us, we can store medication and help to remind the young person to take it when required. Please let us know if you would like us to do this. Otherwise, we allow the young people to self-medicate.
