Dear parents/guardians,

AYF Camp is taking place from **Saturday 18th to Saturday 25th July 2026!** Lots of information is available on our website, but the key things you need to know are below.

Where?

We travel down to the Colandene Centre, Colindene Road, Bradworthy, Devon, EX22 7RN. The site is a disused dairy farm with fields, and a converted barn with toilets, showers and a games area. We set up marquees for cooking and activities, and we provide bell tents for the teenagers to sleep in.

We travel down to the site, and get around during the week, on minibuses. All travel and accommodation costs are included in the fee for the week.

What Is It?

Camp is the highlight of our year. A typical day starts off with breakfast, with the teenagers taking it in turns to cook each meal in groups, supervised by leaders. We then have our morning study groups, where we learn about and discuss different aspects of faith. After lunch, we normally head to the beach, or play games on site, until dinner time. Our evenings mainly consist of sung worship and a talk. We add into this “quiet time wars” – where the study groups battle it out in a series of team challenges – and bonfires, walks, games, and much more.

How Do I Sign Up?

To sign your teenager up for Camp, please fill in the form on Page 2, and return it to us. You can either hand it in to a leader, or scan and e-mail it to aldridgeyouthfellowship@gmail.com.

The form needs to be accompanied by payment of a booking fee – details are on Page 3.

The form must be filled in and signed by a parent or legal guardian.

On very rare occasions, we have had to abandon camp and send teenagers home. This could be due to bad weather, logistical problems, illness, or misbehaviour. It is important that a parent or guardian is available and contactable during the week of Camp in case a teenager needs to come home. If this is not possible, please leave details below of a nominated person who will be available instead.

Parental Consent

1. I agree to my son/daughter taking part in AYF camp activities
2. I understand that the leaders who are responsible for the activities will take all reasonable care of participants
3. I consent to any emergency treatment necessary. I therefore authorise the group leaders to sign on my behalf any written form of consent required by the hospital authorities should medical treatment (including a surgical operation or injection) be deemed necessary, provided the delay required to obtain my signature might be considered, in the opinion of the doctor or surgeon concerned, likely to endanger my son's/daughter's health or safety.
4. Should the need arise I give consent for registered first aiders to administer minor first aid treatments.

Note: The medical profession takes the view that the parent's/carer's consent to medical treatment cannot be delegated. This view is explicit in The Children's Act 1989. Thus, medical consent forms have no legal status and a doctor or nurse insisting on the consent of a parent/carer to a particular treatment has the right to do so.

For this reason, we do not insist on parents/carers signing the above statement. However, it can be a comfort to medical staff to have general consent in advance from parents/carers or to have a leader on hand able to sign forms required by medical authorities.

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Payment and Terms

The cost of the week is £250, which is inclusive of transport, campsite fees and food.

For families with more than one teenager attending, we offer a discounted rate of £460 for both.

Your teenager may want to bring spending money for days when we visit Bude town.

In order to reserve a place on Camp, payment of a non-refundable booking fee of £50 is needed at the time of booking. To make this payment, please go to our website (ayf.aldridgeparish.org.uk) and follow the instructions. Only once this payment and the registration form have been received will a place be reserved. This payment is non-refundable in case of cancellation by you.

For families with more than one teenager attending, we need a separate registration form and £50 booking fee per child.

The balance payment (total cost minus booking fee) is due on 1st July 2026. We will send a reminder in advance of this date. After 1st July, payments can not be refunded in case of cancellation by you. (This is because we will be making payments for minibuses, food suppliers etc which we will not be able to cancel.)
